\*Students will be able to know about the endangered specie (Tigers) in episode A Hero.


Why did the man eater guard the prey? Create a food chain using the prey, man eater and other members of your own imagination.

Also find out five names of other endangered species and paste their pictures.




- Make a comparative study of storage devices (any two) used in ancient times and new era on the basis of the following terms: o Speed o Size o Memory
